SYNAXIS OF THE HOLY ARCHANGELS

In the month of November, we celebrate the Synaxis of all the bodiless powers of heaven, but in particular the two great Archangels Michael and Gabriel, the mentors of our parish.

As faithful Christians, we recite the Symbol of Faith, at every Divine Liturgy as well as during our morning and evening prayers. This is the confession into which we were baptized and became members of the Church, the Body of Christ. In this Creed, we confess our belief in one God who is maker "of all things visible and invisible", that is, of both the material and spiritual parts of creation. The tradition of the Church tells us about an invisible spiritual world which is much more vast than the material world we see with our eyes. The inhabitants of this spiritual world are far more numerous than us human beings. As we read in the Divine Liturgy every Sunday, they are "angels, archangels, thrones, dominions, principalities, authorities, powers, the many-eyed Cherubim" and the six-winged Seraphim,

The Archangel Michael, who is normally depicted with a sword in his hand, is the defender against evil and sin. In many icons we see, beneath his feet, Satan, who was the former angel of light, Lucifer. As you know, the fall of man was preceded by the fall of a third of the angels — "I beheld Satan as lightning fall from heaven", says the Lord (Luke 10:18). This fall is described in greater detail in the Revelation of John: "There was war in heaven: Michael and his angels fought against the dragon; and the dragon fought with his angels and prevailed not; neither was their place found any more in heaven. And the great dragon

was cast out, that old serpent, called the Devil, and Satan, which deceiveth the whole world: he was cast out into the earth, and his angels were cast out with him" (Revelation 12:7–9).

Tradition tells us that Michael, on seeing the fall of Satan and his angels, cried out to the remaining angels, "Let us stand with awe, let us stand with fear!", exhorting them to remain faithful. We too, at every Divine Liturgy, begin the anaphora — the summit of Christian worship — with the same exhortation: "Let us stand with awe, let us stand with fear, let us attend to the holy oblation, that in peace we may offer mercy, peace: a sacrifice of praise". We use Archangel's words because that war is also our war, because it is not only angels and demons who belong to the invisible world — we human beings do too.

Man is unique among creatures in that he alone is both material and spiritual. The purpose of man is to unite those two parts of creation — the material and the spiritual — the human being to be in constant communion with God and through him, the whole of creation. And as a leader of creation, to offer back to God the whole of the world in order that the whole world may be united to Him.

This is why we see that, with the fall of the angels, only angels fell, but with the fall of man, the entire world fell. And it is this position that Gabriel, the second Archangel, calls us back to, when with the words "rejoice" and "fear not," he announces to us the restoration of humanity through the incarnation, death, and resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ.





On October 29, Taxiarchae hosted renowned OCMC missionary Nathan Hoppe, who has served in Albania for the past 25 years. Over that time, he has helped resurrect the Orthodox Church of Albania after 45 years of persecution and enforced atheism under the communist government (1945-1991).

Thirty-five parishioners gathered for dinner, fellowship, and an inspirational talk. Nathan implored us to share our faith with others who have not chosen Christ and Orthodoxy. If our faith is just something we keep inside, then is it truly something that we highly value? Rather, we are obligated to share it with others.

OCMC (Orthodox Christian Mission Center) is the world's only pan-Orthodox mission agency and has sent over 100 missionaries, supports hundreds of priests, and provided millions of dollars of grants for theological training and building churches in over 50 countries around the world.

The event was sponsored by Frank Catrickes, an OCMC Board member, who noted that Christ's final commandment given to his Disciples after he was crucified, resurrected, and right before returning to Heaven was the "Great Commission:"

Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely, I am with you always, to the very end of the age. Matthew 28:19-20










Join us at our next GOYA gathering
