THE HOLY CROSS AS A SYMBOL OF VICTORY OVER DEATH by Fr. Athanasios Nenes

The feast of the universal elevation of the Holy Cross is the first Lord's feast of the ecclesiastical year. In it, the highlight of Divine Providence, the crucifixion of Christ, is emphasized, as the greatest symbol of God's love for man, which is the Holy Cross, is raised before us as a trophy of victory over death. The holiday conveys the joyous message that "Through the decay of wood, the death that comes to mankind, through the Cross is removed today" (hymn of the matins of the feast) as an answer to the problem of death.

The resurrectional sermon of the feast leads us to experience the crucifixion of Christ as a new spiritual "Pascha" and a prelude to the age to come. With the Cross of Christ, a new reality is inaugurated, in which the resurrection that "renew the universes" is projected as the final solution to the human historical drama, with Christ being the *"First of those who have fallen asleep"* (1 Cor. 15:20).

The resurrection of the dead is the certain expectation of the faithful that is renewed through the presence of the Holy Cross in everyone's life. Participation in the celebration of the elevation of the Holy Cross gives the life of the faithful an eschatological direction and in the present time its eternal extension. The Holy Cross, as a symbol of victory against death, reminds us that humanity, with Christ's sacrifice on the cross, gains immortality and life as the permanent and dignified solution to the terrible fact of death. With the Holy Cross from which life finally sprung forth, the immutable law of true life is confirmed according to which "the seed you sow does not come to life unless it dies" (I Cor. 15:36). With the crucifixion of Christ, "the foundations of death were shaken" (matins of the feast) and man was given the opportunity to face death with courage as a gateway to eternity and not as an eternal loss. Indeed, Christ's death on the cross is a death of immortality, with which Adam's handwriting



was torn, because the Lord Redeemed us from the curse of the law with His precious blood.

With the celebration of the universal elevation of the Holy Cross, it is understood that with the cross of Christ "by the fallen, death's power" (vespers of the feast) man is raised to a new life of joy and incorruption, freed from the fear of death by the personal experience of co-crucifixion and co-resurrection with Christ. With the Cross of Christ, man is no longer tied to death, but moves from death to life.

The symbol of the Holy Cross, by which death was brought down to the end, proves that man is created to live in the joy of resurrection not as a kind of philosophical concept, but as a guarantee for the fulfillment of the resurrection of humankind. The faithful, participating in the sacrifice of Christ with the Holy Cross, despises his own death, treating it as a simple impression and temporary condition. Christ "who through the Cross abolished death and set us free" (matins of the feast) conveys the certainty of the resurrection of the dead, which abolishes the fear, pain, and despair of death, while strengthening hope and strengthening faith in the afterlife eternity. Now with the Cross of Christ death acquires a positive value.

Modern man is called to perceive death as mysticism who brings out the meaning of the mystery and the dimension of the depth of life in the light of Christ's sacrifice on the cross. As long as man is aware of the new world that opens before him with the Cross, he breathes the free air of resurrection.

In this way the cross of the Lord is transformed from a symbol of horrible condemnation for its time into a universal symbol of glory, life, and victory over death. The willingness of Christ with the cross sacrifice and death, leads us to the kingdom of life and opens the way of resurrection.




